Last year, we celebrated the Centennial of The Rotary Foundation (TRF) – 100 years of "Doing Good in the World." This is our 101st year of the Foundation. Our foundation has been named "The World's Outstanding Foundation" for 2016 by the Association of Fundraising Professionals. TRF has again received a 4-star rating from Charity Navigator (a score of 97.87 out of 100 points) for both financial performance and accountability/transparency.

The mission of TRF is "to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty." "The Rotary Foundation transforms your gifts into service projects that change lives both close to home and around the world."

provides a global reach. TRF enables us to


