50 Things Every Rotarian Should Know About Rotary (first in a series)

1. DEFINITION OF ROTARY

How do you describe the organization called "Rotary"? There are so many characteristics of a Rotary club as well as the activities of a million Rotarians. There are the features of service, internationality, fellowship, classifications of each vocation, development of goodwill and world understanding, the emphasis of high ethical standards, concern for other people and many more descriptive qualities.

In 1976 the Rotary International Board of Directors was interested in creating a concise definition of the fundamental aspects of Rotary. They turned to the three men who were then serving on Rotary's Public Relation Committee and requested that a one-sentence definition of Rotary be prepared. After numerous drafts, the committee presented this definition, which has been used ever since in various Rotary publications:

"Rotary is an organization of business and professional persons united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations and help build goodwill and peace in the world."

Those 31 words are worth remembering when someone asks, "What is a Rotary club?"

April is Maternal and Child Health Month

Maternal and Child Health - Risks and Remedies



What is the problem?
Every day in the world, 800 women die from pregnancy - or childbirth-related complications.

· A woman's lifetime risk of maternal death in

developing countries is 1 in 150 in contrast to 1 in 4700 in developed countries.

- · The major causes accounting for 80% of all maternal deaths are: severe bleeding (hemorrhage), infections, high blood pressure (eclampsia), obstructed labor and unsafe abortions.
- · More than 6 million children under the age of five die each year from disease, malnutrition, lack of access to healthcare, and inadequate sanitation.
- · Many hospitals in developing countries lack necessary equipment and well-trained health personnel, a steady supply of water and energy; and poor hygienic conditions.

What can we do about it?

- · Support graduate study in maternal and child health.
- · Build capacity of communities and women's groups.
- · Provide vocational training on child and maternal health.
- · Support improved maternal care.
- · Support improved reproductive health.
- \cdot Provide education and training to reduce child mortality.

What is Rotary doing?

- · Rotary programs provide education, immunizations, birth kits, and mobile health clinics.
- · Rotary programs teach women how to prevent mother-to-infant HIV transmission, how to breast-feed, and how to protect themselves and their children from disease.
