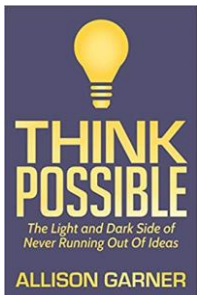

Wednesday, 10/24, 5-7pm

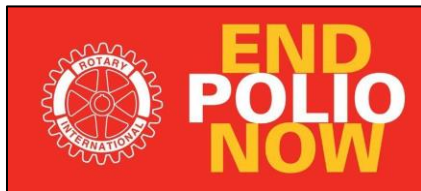
Join us for cocktails and a fundraiser for World Polio Day!
