### Mission

Our mission is to offer our local World War II, Korean War, and Vietnam veterans a memorable, safe and rewarding tour of honor to our nation's capital. It's a whirlwind tour. This trip happens all in one day and is completely free of charge to the vet! It's our small way to say 'thank you' for their service and sacrifices to this great country. We are also dedicated to making this trip as safe as possible. Trained volunteer 'guardians' are assigned to accompany veterans to assist. For added safety, we travel with volunteer medical professionals on the aircraft and on the ground in Washington DC.

Today, Tony will share Old Glory Honor Flight's History (also when and how National Honor Flight started); eligibility to fly as a veteran; eligibility for a guardian; and how to help keep our veterans flying.

He will share a video showing some pictures of our participants and if time permits a brief slide show of pictures of our trip know as "Return to Nam".
