The mission of the Dementia Care Specialist Program is to support people with dementia and their caregivers in order to ensure the highest quality of life possible while living at home. In order to accomplish this mission, the dementia care specialists (DCSs) have four goals:

- Provide free information and assistance to adults with memory or cognitive concerns, or who have been given a dementia diagnosis.
- Provide information and support to family members and friends who are caregivers.
- Help develop dementia-friendly communities where people with dementia can remain active and safe, and caregivers can feel supported.
- Train other staff at the ADRCs and other county and municipal offices to be dementia-capable.

Crop Walk 2019



The Oshkosh Area Crop Walk is spearheaded every year by high school Rotarians - Interactors, as they are officially called. Churches, businesses and other organizations also field teams and/or sponsor the event.

Half of the money stays local and is distributed to a number of area food pantries including the Oshkosh Area Community Pantry, Father Carr's, the Lutheran Food Pantry, and the meal program of the Day by Day Warming shelter. Half of the money supports hunger relief around the world.

The start time of the Walk (5K) is 1 pm on Sunday October 6th. We will leave from the parking lot behind Lourdes Academy, 100 N Sawyer and cross the river and loop around. The Walk will conclude at the entrance off the parking lot of Zion Lutheran Church a short walk away, 400 N Sawyer.
