The Oshkosh Food Co-Op's mission is to open a member-owned, full-service grocery store in the heart of Oshkosh. A cooperative is a member-owned and member-controlled business that operates for the mutual benefit of all members (in this case, great local food and a healthy community).

The Oshkosh Food Co-op has launched a \$1.6 million capital campaign to open a grocery store at Jackson St and Pearl Ave. Northeast Wisconsin's first food co-op plans to occupy 8,000 square feet on the Brio building's first floor, a location that leaders said was chosen based on its visible location.

1973

Let's Get Organized

A dinner meeting hosted by the Oshkosh Rotary club, on February 6, 1973, saw a sincere interest in a large number of men interested in becoming charter members of the new Rotary club being organized. A maximum of 35 charter members was allowed.

All west side operators of businesses, professions, executives, or representatives were approached about charter membership in the new Rotary Club, and invited to attend the first regular meeting, February 14, 1973. Prospective members that attended both dinner meetings hosted by the parent club were billed the regular fee of \$2.50 for the meal. Prospective members unable to attend either of the informational dinners will be invited as guests of the host club.

Oshkosh Rotary Past President Kenneth Seefeld presided, with Past Secretary, Elmer Harvey giving the program: "The Computer Will Get You if You Don't Watch Out!"

A vote of prospective members present at the February 14, dinner meeting set the regular meeting time as Wednesday noons, from 12:00 Noon until 1:30 PM. Two temporary committees were appointed. Rev. Harold Riebe, served as chairman of the Program Committee, along with Joe Poklasny and George Coghill. Denny Elmer was chairman for finding a meeting place, along with Tim Gunning and John Bloom.

Annual dues were set at \$140, which include fifty noon lunches at \$2.50, International dues \$10.50, and \$4.00 for District 627 dues.
