1973

What's In A Name?

Oshkosh Rotary Southwest was finally decided from: West Side Rotary, Oshkosh Rotary - West, Rotary Club - Southwest, Southwest Oshkosh Rotary. Our weekly publication, *The Rotary Hub*, won out over The Rotary Wheel.

Steady Growth

By February 21, 1973, nineteen members signed up. On February 28, **Jim Bankson**, Ponchatoula, LA was the first out of town Rotarian guest, and records show membership was eighteen. By March 7, three more members joined, and charter membership was closed March 10, 1973.

Charter Submitted

Charter was submitted and granted on March 20, 1973, with

twenty-seven charter members. Oshkosh Rotary Southwest was the 47th club in District 627, one of 15,468 clubs, totaling approximately 725,000 Rotarians worldwide.


