Membership Growth

Early in the year, about September, Governor Mikula congratulated Southwest on gaining three new members, the district high, but...

District Governor Jack Mikula presented Oshkosh Rotary (Downtown) the membership growth trophy for the year.

The year ended with 29 members.

Attendance

At one point in October, the Hub editor chastised members attendance for being as low as 40%. The following month, the Hub editor chastised the membership for coming! Attendance up to 89% and the room was too small.

Budget Woes

Meal cost went up to \$2.75 each week. Annual dues remained at \$140.

The club expenses from noon luncheons, project expenses, dues and charitable contributions were \$4919.42, but dues from the 28 members totaled \$3920.00

Charitable contributions went for three \$50 savings bonds as scholarships, \$14 for a Haiti project, \$240 for Rotary International Foundation.

At the half way point in the year, dues increased to \$45 per quarter, a 30% increase!
