Over the years our Club has morphed from a pure eClub to a hybrid Club, changing with the demands of our Club members. Starting July 1 2020 we have intentionally rethought our Clubs format and how we fit into the Rotary options in the Oshkosh area.

Our Club service projects will focus hands-on projects. Our members want to see the impact of their work. Our goal is to do a service project of some sort every month. As an example, in July Club members made up five greeting cards each to be distributed to area nursing homes to let the residence know there are people thinking of them.
