Recipe of the Week

From our President ...

30-minute Potato Soup

1 – 32oz bag southern style hash browns 1 large box or 2 cans (16oz) chicken broth 1 small yellow onion, diced Salt & pepper to taste

1 can cream of chicken soup 1 can cream of celery soup

1 large can evaporated milk

Bacon bits

Shredded cheddar cheese

Boil hash browns & chopped onion in chicken broth until cooked to your liking. Add salt & pepper to taste. Stir in cream of chicken, cream of celery & evaporated milk, stirring until warm.


Serve in bowls & top with bacon bits & shredded cheese.
