2020 Environmental Leadership Award

The City of Oshkosh Sustainability Advisory Board (SAB) along with the Community Environment & Beautification Committee of Oshkosh Southwest Rotary will award an individual, group, or project for environmental leadership. These awards are designed to recognize those whose environmental leadership has made a significant contribution to the economy and has had a significant impact on the environment.

Nominations forms are available through the link above.

The selection committee will choose the award recipient using the following criteria:

1. Environmental activities within the City of Oshkosh participation over time
2. Leadership contribution (positive and lasting)
3. Development of an innovative or novel program, or facility in use or being considered for use by others
4. Leading or fostering a long-term initiative making a substantial contribution to environmental protection or removal of environmental hazards
5. Leadership influential in achieving a documented substantial improvement in quality of the environment

Applications will be accepted through January 31, 2021. Applications will be reviewed in February 2021 with award recommendations to SAB in March 2021 then out to the City Council for approval. Awards will be given to recipients at the State of the City Address in March 2021.
