These awards are designed to recognize those whose environmental leadership has made a significant contribution to the community and has had a significant impact on the environment.

Registration forms are available through the link above.

The selection committee will choose the award recipient using the following criteria:

1. Environmental activities within the City of Oshkosh jurisdiction over time
2. Leadership contribution (past and present)
3. Development of an innovative or model program, or facility in use or being considered for use by others
4. Leading or fostering a long-term initiative making a substantial contribution to environmental protection or removal of environmental hazards
5. Leadership influential in achieving a documented substantial improvement in quality of the environment

Applications will be accepted through January 31, 2021. Applications will be reviewed in February 2021 with award recommendations to SAB in March 2021 then set to the City Council for approval. Awards will be given to recipients at the State of the City Address in March 2021.

Recipe of the Week Karlene Leatherman

Don't like fruitcake? You might like this!

ORANGE SLICE CAKE

- 3-1/2 cups sifted flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 (8oz) pkg dates
- 1 cup chopped nuts
- 1 pound orange slice candies
- 1 cup butter
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 4 eggs
- 1/2 cup buttermilk
- 1 cup flaked coconut

Sift together flour, salt, soda. Measure 1/2 cup flour & set aside. Cut dates & orange slices; add nuts; coat with the 1/2 cup reserved flour.

Cream butter with sugar until light & fluffy. Add eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add flour alternately with buttermilk, beating until smooth. Add vanilla. Fold in dates, nuts, orange slices & coconut.

Spoon into greased & lightly floured 10" tube pan

Bake @ 300° for 2 hours

Freezes well.
