Perhaps one of the greatest inventors of the 20th century was Thomas Edison.

Edison's work included

groundbreaking inventions and innovations in electricity generation and distribution, communications, sound recording, motion pictures and the modern incandescent light bulb.

Much of what we take for granted in our modern living is directly or indirectly dependent on the work of Edison.

He also changed the model of inventing from an "inspired flash of brilliance" to a defined and deliberate approach by developing the world's first and arguably greatest (at the time) commercial laboratory at Menlo Park.

Edison was a member of the Rotary Club of Orange in New Jersey.
