We hope you will join us for the 2021 Fox-Wolf Watershed Cleanup taking place on Saturday, May 1st from 9am to noon. There are 60+ cleanup sites coordinated throughout our basin along our lakes and rivers, and we've added some new sites this year too! Remember, you can register yourself as well as your family members in one transaction.

We look forward to getting down and cleaning up this May!

What is a Watershed Cleanup?

Each year **hundreds** of volunteers visit one of **60+ sites** coordinated throughout our watershed to remove garbage and debris. Our annual cleanup aims to build a sense of community and increase understanding of the environmental stewardship necessary to improve water quality in our region.

What do volunteers do?

Volunteers start the morning checking in with their Site Leader at their chosen sites. Volunteers then grab their supplies, spread out, and clean up their site.

There are **60+** cleanup sites located along the Fox River, the Wolf River, Lake Butte des Morts, and Lake Winnebago.

Date: Saturday, May 1, 2021 Cleanup: 9:00am – 12:00pm

Volunteers report directly to the cleanup site they registered for. Site leaders hand out t-shirts and supplies and volunteers get to work!

Everyone is welcome to volunteer!

Advance registration is requested to ensure proper supplies are onsite.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and concern for our volunteers' safety, we have decided to forgo hosting our Cleanup Picnic this year. We look forward to seeing you at the Cleanup Picnic following our 2022 Cleanup event.
