Paul Mosling Morton is a grandson of B.A. Mosling, one of the co-

founders of Oshkosh Motor Truck Manufacturing Company, Inc (now Oshkosh Corporation). Paul spent his time in the factory, riding in various Oshkosh trucks, with his dad or a truck tester and accompanied his dad on service calls.

At the same time he collected Oshkosh truck literature and photos.

His interest in the company spans 65 years during which he developed a large file of Oshkosh truck information.

His book **A History of Oshkosh Motor Truck 1874-1969** traces the rich history of the company from its founders starting in Mosling WI to Clintonville WI to its startup in Oshkosh WI in 1916. Story continues onto 1969
