of the Paine Art Center and Gardens, a historic estate with art galleries and display gardens in Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

The museum preserves the property's historic architecture, with the mansion as the centerpiece, and many of the house's interiors as they were created by founders Nathan and Jessie Kimberly Paine. Selections from the museum's art collection, much of which was acquired by Nathan and Jessie, are featured in the many rooms and settings of the estate.

Outdoors, the Paine maintains and enhances numerous display gardens as "galleries" of horticulture with varied designs and thousands of plant specimens.

In addition, the museum presents changing art exhibitions, from classical to contemporary, as well as seasonal events like Nutcracker in the Castle during the holidays.

The Studio, located on the house's lower level, offers a relaxing space for learning and creating, and the Paine hosts a wide range of programs throughout the year in the carriage house and conservatory.
