**Medallion Installation**



The Environmental & Beautification Committee is planning a medallion installation on storm water intakes

along the curbs of an area near South Park. The installation process is simple and perfect for student groups as well as parents with kids.

Installation is done by groups of at least 2 persons to a team who follow a map of given streets to install the medallions on the curb next to the storm sewer intake grates. Installation is via a glued disc that is simple peel and stick

It is essential that we have a minimum of 10 volunteers to complete the area designated for medallions. The install should take only an hour or two (depending on speed of teams).
