Hot news full of great excitement from here in Kaliluni villages, near the City of Machakos, Kenya.

Skygen Foundation whose address is in Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin, successfully launched, an Ophthalmic and Dental Clinics here in Kaliluni, my home village.

For starters, Skygen brought doctors from Wisconsin, and others from Tanzania and Western Kenya. Skygen held a three day health clinic, during which the Doctors and their assistants saw and treated over five hundred people without any charge. Those who needed eye glasses got them free; and there were many of them The people were evaluated for BP, P, Dental, Eyes, and many other unimaginable health concerns.

Lisa Sweeney, Skygen's Executive Director, [Menomonee Falls] and Emanuel Kitoi [Madison, WI] who is the Chairman of Skygen's Projects were all here. And most important to me was Brett Bennett, who in 2021 was our Rotary Club's guest speaker, thru Zoom, and he is the one who in his presentation, introduced me to Skygen. I believe Brett was a guest of our past club President, Mike Vaughan. So big Hurrah for Rotary. Brett was here too.

Skygen Foundation is signing a five year lease with a renewable close to be a partner with KMC hospital. What a blessing for the people of the Kaliluni Villages!
