Today we welcome Tom Fojtik, Executive Director of Oshkosh Healthy Neighborhoods since November, 2021. Prior to assuming that role he served on

the board of directors beginning in 2016. Previously, Tom served as Executive Director for the Oshkosh Area Community Food Pantry for just under three years. He took on this role after working at UW Oshkosh for 35 years, in the Department of Residence Life.

Tom has been active in the community, most notably on the city of Oshkosh Plan Commission, where he served for 15 years, 12 as Commission Chair. He has also served on the board of Junior Achievement, completed the Master Gardeners program, and helped his spouse, Sue, raise two kids and four dogs.

Oshkosh Healthy Neighborhoods works with associations to sponsor community building events where residents can meet, have fun, build trust and social capital in the neighborhood. They also partner with residents, neighborhood groups, and community institutions to identify and implement special neighborhood initiatives aimed at improving the quality of life in our neighborhoods.

On Thursday, October 19, Oshkosh Healthy Neighborhoods will be hosting the first annual "Neighborhood Heroes" event at the beautiful Lakeshore Pavilion. They will be recognizing heroes in four categories: Neighborhood Volunteer, Beautification, Community Support, and Youth.

These awards are designed to recognize those neighborhood residents who do things, large and small, that help make our community a healthier and more enjoyable place to live, work and play. Nominations will come from all of our 23 recognized neighborhood associations. Their intent is to make this a recurring annual event that demonstrates how anyone who invests in our community can make Oshkosh a nicer place to live.
