#### Service as Meditation

Bob Poeschl served 13 years representing Oshkosh and Winnebago County through the Oshkosh Common Council, the Board of Education and the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors. In September 2022, he left elected life to work for Disability Rights Wisconsin, the leading disability rights organization of Wisconsin.

Disability Rights Wisconsin is a private non-profit organization that protects the rights of people with disabilities statewide. Their mission is to advance the dignity, equality, and self-determination of people with disabilities. They work to pursue justice on matters related to human and legal rights. DRW is completely independent of government and the disability service system in order to be free of any conflicts of interests which undermines their capacity to advocate vigorously on behalf of the human and legal rights of people with disabilities.
