Today's speaker is Ken Osmond, small businessman extraordinaire, humanitarian, and a cat lover.

In 2008, Ken Osmond purchased Planet Perk Café which was founded in 1996 and had moved to its current City Center location. Ken purchased the café with one idea in mind, "to prove that a business can be environmentally conscious, socially responsible, act for the betterment of the community and be successful."

Their tagline pretty much says it, "One Planet, Many Perks." Part of the tagline, "One planet" refers to the fact that we only have one planet, so we better take care of it. The other part, "many perks", refers to the many incredible things about our planet, our country, and our community that make life so precious and wonderful.

Today Ken will share about Planet Perk and the many things they do for our community. But he'll also be talking about The Planet Purrrk Club, a cat lounge, co-working space, and study hall. It is the result of a collaboration between Planet Perk Coffee Houses and the Oshkosh Area Humane Society. The cat lounge is home to an average of 15 cats that are all fully adoptable. They are all healthy, spayed or neutered, micro-chipped, and have all of the vaccinations up to date. Each cat is ready to find their forever home.

She actively participated in the Paul Harris 711 Club, dedicated to preserving Paul Harris' office as a Rotary landmark and maintaining Rotary's history.
