On occasion, it's a good idea to reacquaint ourselves with the governing concepts of Rotary International. This week we're looking at the OBJECT of Rotary and the use of Rotary databases and directories. Please take a moment to read through the following:

From the Constitution of Rotary International (Article 4: OBJECT): The object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as the basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

First: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

Second: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

Third: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life;

Fourth: The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

From the Manual of Procedure of Rotary International: Commercializing Rotary.
