The new E-Club will meet on Thursday evenings from 5:15 to 6:15 p.m. (location to be determined). The tentative schedule will be: Week 1) a traditional "in-person" meeting with a speaker, drinks and appetizers; Week 2) a "virtual" (on-line) meeting with a featured speaker; Week 3) Happy Hour, social meeting; Week 4) Virtual meeting; and (if necessary) Week 5) a volunteer opportunity.

The Rotary District 9820 GSE Team (from Australia) will arrive in Milwaukee on April 7 and travel throughout District 6270. They'll be hosted by Oshkosh Southwest, Ripon, Berlin and Montello Rotary Clubs the week of April 15 to 21. They'll visit with steel fabricators, university school of business, medical centers and schools, and a dairy farm and veterinary software company.
