2012 Giving Summary

The Oshkosh Southwest Rotary Club has posted our 2012 charitable giving summary on our club website, find out who shared \$125, 279 in gifts at www.OshkoshRotarySouthwest.org.

Highlights include:

\$11,000 in scholarships; \$23,000 to youth clubs from raffle sales proceeds; \$27,000 to the Peru soy Cow Project; our members also contributed nearly \$15,000 to the Rotary International Foundation and our own Southwest Rotary Foundation.

Battle on Bago

The 6th annual Battle on 'Bago ice fishing tournament will take place on Feb. 22 and 23 in Menominee Park. This is the largest fundraiser of the year for our club and one the largest events of the year in Oshkosh.

Even before the anglers take to the ice our club, and many of our partner organizations, have the opportunity to raise fund through the sale of raffle tickets. 100% of all proceeds generated by our club members through raffle ticket sales will remain with our club.

This year we have a special Battle on 'Bago ice shanty that will be set up around town as a raffle ticket point of sale.

We are thrilled to have the opportunity to have an exhibit booth to sell raffle tickets at the All Canada show! The All-Canada Show is a traveling exhibition of all things for fishing and hunting in Canada. It is 1/24 - 1/27 (Thursday – Sunday) in Green Bay at Shopko Hall (across from Lambeau Field).

We will have a lot of fun with our Battle on Bago Limited Edition Ice Shanty in our exhibit booth! We need Rotarians to work our booth all 4 days. About 6000 people attend this show so this is a great opportunity for us to sell a ton of raffle tickets. 100% of what we sell go directly to the programs our club support. You can't get any better than that!
