#### Battle on Bago

It's time for Battle on Bago raffle ticket sales. Pick up your pack of tickets from a community service chair. Each Rotarian will receive an envelope with 15 raffle tickets. Our club keeps 100% of the proceeds from tickets sold by our club members.

Battle on Bago will take place Friday and Saturday, February 21 and 22 in Menominee Park. With a \$160,000 prize pool this is the largest ice fishing tournament in the country and it's our clubs largest fundraiser for the year.

Not only do we need your help selling raffle tickets, but we also need volunteers for both Friday and Saturday. Sign-up sheets will circulate soon. Spouses, family members and friends are welcome to volunteer. Finally,

help spread the word about this unique tournament where the biggest prizes instead they fall in interesting spots, like a Ford F150 truck for 150<sup>th</sup> place.
