

My name is Hannah Hupfer and I am the Volunteer and Events Coordinator at the Salvation Army in Oshkosh. It is my first week with the Salvation Army and I hope I can make a difference.

We are always on the lookout for volunteers to aid in our commitment to serve the less fortunate in our community. Our biggest campaign is the **Red Kettle Campaign**. We have opportunities available from now until December 24th for bell ringing.

The Salvation Army has many great programs that we offer to those in need. Approximately 50,000 meals are prepared and served free of charge by The Salvation Army Oshkosh to those who can't feed themselves either due to poverty or disability. We have a food pantry that nearly one in ten Oshkosh households use for emergency food assistance each year. We also offer seasonal programs such as Adopt A Family, Coats for Kids, Toys for Tots, and Angel Tree to help ensure every Oshkosh area child can enjoy the holidays regardless of their parents' financial situation. If your group is interested in helping the Oshkosh community as bell ringers, now is the time to sign up!
