## Recipe of the Week Craig Burnett

Here's another from Craig Burnett (also from Men Who Cook):

#### Portobello Mushroom Quesadilla Bites

#### Ingredients

1 small white onion, chopped fine

1 Portobello mushroom cap, chopped

1 medium firm tomato, peeled & diced

2 cups masa harina ("masa mix")

1-1/2 cups water

1/2 tsp salt

vegetable oil

Monterey Jack cheese

#### Preparation

Sauté onions in 2 Tbl oil until almost softened. Add mushrooms and cook over medium heat until softened. Set aside to cool to room temperature. Once cool, mix in diced tomato. Mix masa harina, water and salt until it forms a dough. Knead dough thoroughly; about 2 or 3 minutes. Break off dough into 1-inch balls. Flatten balls with rolling pin into 3-inch circles. Fill 1/2 of each dough circle with mushroom mix and top with Monterey Jack cheese. Fold dough over and pinch edges to seal. Heat 1 inch of oil in deep skillet over medium heat. Fry quesadillas, turning several times, until golden brown. Dry on paper towel. Serve hot.
