## Famous Rotarians



While Luciano Pavarotti was almost universally known as a world class

operatic tenor, he was also a world class humanitarian.

Pavarotti used his voice, his fame and his ability to fill a concert hall to stage many concerts for charities, disaster relief and other humanitarian causes.

He teamed up with his friend Lady Diana to raise awareness and millions of dollars for the eradication of landmines.

In 2001, Pavarotti received the Nansen Medal from the UN High Commission for Refugees for his efforts raising money on behalf of refugees worldwide. Through benefit concerts and volunteer work, he raised more than any other individual. He was also the recipient of the Red Cross "Award for Services to Humanity", for his work in raising money for that organization worldwide.

Pavarotti was a member of the Rotary Club of Moderna, Italy.
