This exciting neighborhood  
revitalization initiative called "Rock the  
Block Oshkosh" utilizes neighborhood  
association members, city loans and  
local grant funding for exterior home  
improvement. The purpose is to get  
neighbors and the greater community  
working together to improve their city.

Many projects are free to the  
homeowner. Additional projects may  
be discussed on a case by case basis,  
and financing may be available to  
homeowners through City of Oshkosh  
micro-grant or zero interest deferred  
loan programs. Rock the Block  
Oshkosh is presented by Habitat for  
Humanity of Oshkosh, Oshkosh  
Healthy Neighborhoods (GO-HNI), and  
the City of Oshkosh through a  
generous grant from US Venture Basic  
Needs Giving Program.
