## Today's Presentation

Today we welcome Dr Kerry Ahrens and Brett Leitl BSN RN to tell us about Telestroke.

#### What Is Telestroke?

Telestroke uses state-of-the-art telemedicine technology - special cameras and microphones - to facilitate communication between two locations. Telestroke allows stroke experts such as neurologists at one hospital to examine patients at another hospital miles away. The stroke expert works with local health care professionals to diagnose conditions and develop care plans.

#### Telestroke's Advantages

With telestroke, patients can have a consultation with a qualified stroke specialist anytime, day or night. The program offers several benefits:

- Connects patients with treatment recommendations from a team of experts
- Lowers healthcare costs
- Provides 24/7/365 bedside access to stroke experts at more facilities
- Allows treatments such as clot-busting drugs to be administered sooner
- Reduces the risk for stroke-related disability
- Reduces the need for patients to transfer to another facility
- Allows ongoing professional treatment at the patient's local hospital

The American Heart Association recommends using telemedicine within stroke care protocols. Telestroke extends quality stroke care to communities where qualified health care professionals aren't always available
