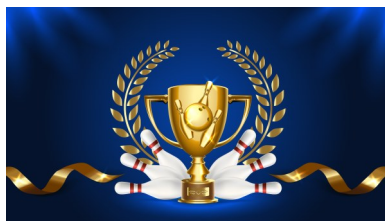

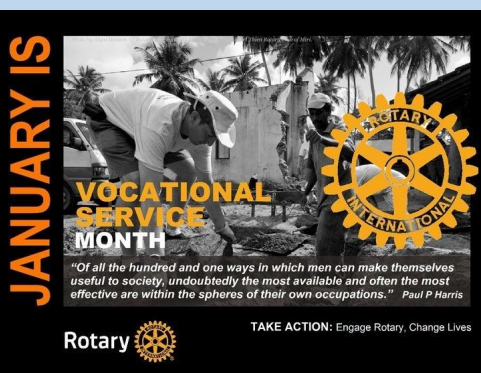
January is Vocational Service Month In Rotary
