Out of a desire to connect with and support other local artists, Jessica created the Oshkosh Art Collective in 2019. What started as a small online community, has grown into an incredible group of talented artists from all different backgrounds.

The Oshkosh Art Collective is a supportive community dedicated to highlighting local artists and art initiatives in the Oshkosh area. Jessica's goal is to support local artists of all experience levels and to cultivate more creative opportunities in the Fox Valley, WI area.

The annual Oshkosh Art Collective Show takes places every April in downtown with three main goals: to cultivate an appreciation for local art and artists in the community, to provide an opportunity for artists to share and sell their work, and to create connections between artists and local businesses. Some of the events the OAC has partnered with include the Algoma Alley Activation Project, the Downtown Oshkosh Chalk Walk, the Streets of Hope Fundraiser, and the Annual Art Supply Swap where artists bring gently used art supplies to swap with other artists or donate. Donated art supplies benefit the Christine Ann Domestic Abuse Services Center.
