Southwest Rotary Around the World

Southwest Rotary Club of Oshkosh takes Rotary's "Service Above Self" motto beyond Oshkosh to other continents thanks to several members who help coordinate international service efforts. Following is an update on one of our projects from fellow Rotarian, Samuel Muinde. Currently, there are more than ten different projects in Kenya, Africa, that have been successfully completed primarily with funding from our Rotary club. The current project involves installing a fence around the Kaliluni Girls Secondary School to protect the students.

The safety and protection of the Kaliluni Girls Secondary School has been one of the most thrilling and gratifying projects under the Kaliluni Related Projects that my committee has ever undertaken. The fencing project will cover the entire perimeter of the Kaliluni Girls Secondary School compound which is slightly over one mile long.



There are two different crews working on this project. One crew is involved in clearing all the trees and bushes in the path of the new fence and constructing the fence. The second crew is composed of masons, who are building an eight-foot-tall wall built with quarry stones around and behind the girls' dormitories.



When the wall and fencing projects are all done, 10,000 seedlings of a thorny tree shrub common to the area will be planted all along the finished fence and wall. These plants will not only add to the security of any animal or person breaching the wall, but will also grow tall and add an ornamental beauty to the fence.



Since 1972, the Kaliluni Girls Secondary School, has been the beneficiary of six acres of land to build the school thanks to the generosity of Kitz & Pfeil Tours (Jim Staple and his dear Parents), Oshkosh Southwest Rotary, The Mosling Family of Oshkosh Truck, Lutheran Church of Oshkosh, Trinity Episcopal Church of Oshkosh, 4imprint, and Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Muinde Soo.

This project has provided employment to many families within the Kaliluni Villages. Families have been
