Southwest Rotary Around the World

SEPO means hope in Lozi language. For the past 15 years, SEPO has worked with the people of western Zambia to provide funding and assistance for projects to improve their community.

SEPO was founded by Mushe and Ang Subulwa as a way to stay connected and support the community that supported Mushe during his childhood. Rotary has been working with SEPO since 2018 with two projects—the Kalungu school and the Mabumbu health center.

During our 2024 trip through the generous funds provided by Oshkosh Southwest Rotary and others, we were able to provide mattresses and supplies to the Mabumbu clinic and birth center, and complete a new classroom block and furnish it with desks and tables. My family was involved with fundraising and gathering supplies and then were fortunate enough to visit the school and clinic in June with Ang and Mushe.
