District Governor 2028-29 Nominations

Rotary District 6270 is now inviting nominations from clubs for the position of **District Governor for the Rotary year 2028–2029.**

Serving as District Governor is one of Rotary's highest honors. The Governor is Rotary International's official representative in the district—leading clubs, inspiring members, strengthening Rotary's public image, and advancing the mission of service. It is a role that is both challenging and deeply rewarding

KEY DETAILS

- Deadline for nominations: **October 15, 2025** (sooner is better).
- Who may nominate: Only Rotary clubs may submit nominations (not individuals – speak to your club secretary/president if you have ideas).
- Eligibility: Candidates must be active Rotarians in good standing, have served a full term as club president, and meet qualifications outlined in Rotary International Bylaws.
- Process: Clubs should submit the completed Governor Nominee Data Form and Rotary résumé to the Nominating Committee Chair. Eligible candidates will be invited to interview with the District Nominating Committee in November.



- Classes starting in October


