Dawn Fiedler serves as Rotary District 6270 District Governor for 2026-2027 and is a past president of the Elkhorn Rotary Club. She has also served as Assistant District Governor, Member-at-Large for medium-sized clubs, and as a board member of the Rotary Club to End Human Trafficking in District 5950.

Dawn is the founder and president of Join the Movement Events, Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to raising awareness and providing education about human trafficking.

Inspired by a Rotary District conference, Dawn founded the organization in 2017 and has since focused on helping communities recognize the signs of trafficking and respond effectively. Through her presentations, Dawn provides industry-specific education for business and community leaders, with a focus on prevention, social media awareness, and internet safety. She advocates for survivors by connecting them with resources that support lasting change.

Dawn is also a founding member and current chair of the Walworth County Anti-Human Trafficking Task Force. She and her husband, Peter, are blessed with four sons, three daughters-in-law, three granddaughters, and two grandsons.
